

MANZ-Every Educaid Study Grant 2016

Background

The gold sponsor of the MANZ conference, Every Educaid, has generously donated a study grant of \$1000 which is available for kaiako (teachers) in MANZ member centres and kura (schools) to apply for to assist them on their journey as life-long learners. This is the third year that Every Educaid has offered this.

Criteria

The study grant aims to support teachers in their knowledge and understanding of Montessori education.

Application Dates

Applications must be received by June 30th.

Assessment of Application

Study grant applications will be selected by the MANZ Council, with the support of Sarah Bowman, Every Educaid. It will be presented at MANZ conference 2016.

Budget

You will need to provide a budget for the study grant funds you are applying for giving details of how the study grant will be spent. You must provide receipts of costs with your final report.

What could be funded?

Costs that may be considered include costs to attend Montessori professional learning events, Montessori study or tuition costs, Montessori books or subscriptions. Other costs may also be considered.

Eligibility

Kaiako in MANZ member centres and schools and individual members of MANZ are eligible to apply for the study grant.

Report

A short study report or reflection will be required to show how the grant has supported your learning. Information on study grants may also be included in MANZ publications.

Failure to Complete Study Grant

The study grant is required to be repaid if the applicant fails to carry out the proposed study. Special circumstances will be taken into consideration.
