

Binda Goldsbrough Research Fund

1. Background

MANZ has set aside a research fund to provide a practical means of supporting Montessori research in New Zealand.

2. Pool of Funding

The research fund comes from interest from MANZ funds. Interest gained in the previous year becomes the Research Fund amount for the following year.

3. Criteria

Research proposals should be based in and benefit Montessori education in New Zealand.

4. Application Dates

Applications can be sent at any time during the year and are announced at conference each year.

5. Assessment of Application

Research applications for funding will be selected by the MANZ Council, with the support of current Montessori researchers in New Zealand or overseas. Recipients will be advised at earliest notice.

6. Budget

You will need to provide a budget for the funds you are applying for giving details of how the research fund will be spent and provide receipts of costs with your final report.

7. What could be funded?

Costs that may be considered include replacement teacher funding, equipment hire (eg. video cameras or audio recorders), transcription costs, koha to participants, travel and accommodation at other locations and books or subscriptions required for the research. Other costs may also be considered.

8. Eligibility

Kaiako (teachers) in MANZ member centres and schools and individual members of MANZ interested in conducting research projects in the area of Montessori philosophy and practice are invited to apply for the MANZ Research Fund. To become an individual see www.montessori.org.nz/join-manz If research is conducted in Montessori early childhood centres, primary or secondary schools, then these centres/schools must be members of MANZ.

9. Report

A research report will be required every 3 months and within three months after the specified end of the project. Failure to produce the report will mean that MANZ will seek to recover the research grant, at the applicant's cost.

10. Failure to Complete Project

The project fund is required to be repaid if the applicant fails to carry out the research project. Special circumstances will be taken into consideration.

Guidelines for MANZ Research Fund Application

1. Personal details

Complete this section, providing all details.

If the research project will be undertaken by more than one researcher, please provide details of all people involved.

2. Research Setting

If the research setting is a Montessori early childhood centre or school, then the centre or school must be a member of Montessori Aotearoa New Zealand.

The principal or owner/manager of the centre(s)or school(s) participating in the research should sign the application form to show that they are aware of the research project and that they will provide all the necessary facilities, time etc to allow the proposed research project to be undertaken.

If the research setting is not in a Montessori early childhood centre or school, please describe the research setting.

3. Academic Details

Give a breakdown of the qualifications that you or your team have attained, the institution and the year.

4. Relevant Work Experience

Give a breakdown of any previous work experience, concentrating on those periods of employment which are directly relevant to your proposed programme of research.

5. Reason for Application

Briefly state what has motivated you to apply for support from the MANZ Research Fund.

6. Proposed Research Project

This section relates directly to the research project that you are proposing to undertake.

7. Project Title

Eight words or fewer, give a title which encapsulates the nature of your proposed project of research.

8. Project Abstract

Provide a brief summary of your proposed research project.

9. Project Objectives and Method(s)

Objectives should be achievable in the time frame indicated. The objective description should include:

- a statement giving the aim of the objective(s);
- an indication as to why the research is being done;
- an indication of the methodology (what you will do) and the timeframe for the research.

10. Research Findings

Explain how the findings of the research will be passed on and shared with the national and/or international Montessori community.

11. Referees

Please provide two referees and their contact details who can be contacted about this application. Please note that MANZ Council may independently obtain reports from other people it considers competent to referee your proposal.

12. Funding

Please specify in detail expenses you may have in relation to the research and the funds you are applying for.

13. Ethical Statement

You need to provide evidence of obtaining or having obtained ethical clearance for the research from an appropriate Ethics Committee, if appropriate. This statement should affirm that the proposed research is ethically acceptable within your discipline.

14. Declaration

Please ensure that all information contained in the application is true and accurate in every particular.
